

## Terrebonne Parish Fire District #10

Dularge Volunteer Fire Department was started in 1968 by a few men from the community, as they went thru the year they decided that they needed more help, they went to the Police Jury and ask for a mill-age tax. The Police Jury created Terrebonne Parish Fire District #10 in 1969; A District Board was formed to handle all District monies.

They built the Central Fire station and hired a full time fire fighter in 1969. They responded to approximately 2-3 fires that year.

In 1976 the District saved enough money to purchase 2 new fire apparatus and built two sub-stations. They responded to approx. 50 emergencies that year.

In 1982, The District noticed that there was a need for rescue service in the community. They purchased 2 rescue trucks, they responded to approx. 100 emergencies that year.

In 1990, The District sent 8 members to the First Responders class and started running medical calls. They responded to approx 200 emergencies that year.

In 1997, The District leased a piece of property from the Gym and built a sub-station on Dr. Beatrous Rd., and bought two used fire apparatus from Gibson fire Dept. They responded to approx. 280 emergencies that year.

In 2000, The District purchased 2 new fire apparatus to replace the 2 oldest trucks in the District. The District responded to 387 emergencies that year.

In 2004, The District purchased a new rescue squad to replace the one at the central station. They responded to 298 emergencies for that year.

In 2006, The District responded to 324 emergencies that year.
